## Member Update (Kris Steinmetz, Legislative Update)



- April has been proclaimed as Autism Acceptance Month
- Bills discussed by Kris
  - ✓ <u>SF68</u>- Governor's education savings plan/private school vouchers
  - √ SF494- Public assistance reform, asset tests for SNAP
  - ✓ <u>HF602</u>- student suicide prevention, Your Life Iowa on Student ID Cards
  - √ <u>HF604</u>- Removing disruptive students from classrooms
  - √ HF608- Seizure ready schools
  - ✓ SF210 and HF273- Changing mental health and behavioral health to brain health
  - ✓ HF252- Comprehensive transition scholarships for programs like REACH, NEXT, etc.
  - √ HF243 and SSB1050- Remove age and dollar caps in Autism treatment
  - √ HF610 and SF343- Excused absences for autism related medical treatments
  - √ <u>HSB49</u>- Creating an autism waiver

# Member Updates (Kelly Pelzel, ImPACT Providers)



- ImPACT is one of a group of naturalistic developmental behavioral intervention blending principles of ABA, speech language training, and developmental approaches like you would see in Floor Time
- Kelly does course training and has trained ~66 people and is now hoping to offer the training once each year
  with a balance of clinicians from within and outside of the University. Targeting a time around the beginning
  of fall semester.
- Next steps are to build a database to see who is practicing and accepting referrals.
- Currently the University of Iowa and ChildServe are offering the ImPACT program
- The time investment looks like 6 hours of online didactics and 14 hours of face-to-face training. This should be bolstered with outside practicing and learning before you'll be ready to teach.

#### Member Update (Andrea Keith, Vocational Rehabilitation)

- Officially under Iowa Workforce Development agency and report to Director Townsend instead of the Board of Education. IVRS will lose 25 support positions and those employees will find positions within Workforce.
- This change has prompted some concerns about Voc Rehab's relationship with the schools and ease of access to the students/student information but at this point, they have no insight on how things will pan out.

## Member Update (Erika Hertel, CASP Conference and Autism in Black)

- Attended the Autism in Black conference and communicated with Leondra Dodd, Senior Advisor for Health Investigations (Mental Health Parity Compliance) for the US Department of Labor at the Kansas City Regional Office. She asked if we could meet to discuss Iowa residents' challenges receiving autism care, including insurance obstacles like prior authorization and medical necessity denials. Some of the topics of concern that brought up during member discussion were:
  - Insurance companies stating they need certain diagnosis tests or scores for the patient to receive interventions
  - The age and dollar caps in the bill that didn't pass <u>HF243</u> and <u>SSB1050</u>
  - ABA and some other mental health services not being covered under HAWK-I and needs some legislative support
  - o Insurance denials based on no recommendation of ABA by a physician for an autistic adult
  - o Issues with denials because the provider who diagnosed was an ARNP
  - Not having enough physicians that meet the Iowa law criteria. ARNP in the current areas allowed should be accepted for dx
