The mission of this training is to equip families of Children and Youth with Special Healthcare Needs with the necessary skills to share their stories well in a variety of settings and modes of delivery in order to bring awareness and change to the system of care for children with special needs.

In this training, participants will:

1. Understand the essential value of their family experience
2. Gain knowledge of types of stories and their uses
3. Craft a story from their lived experience for awareness and change
4. Craft a short elevator speech
5. Develop presentation skills

Participants will work with a coach and cohort of 3 family storytellers. The course will be held online using Google Classroom. Stories will be told in small groups using Zoom.
